The Post will be hosting its annual Ceremony for the Disposal of Unserviceable Flags at the Post Home on Willow Grove Street on Sunday Evening **May 20th. At 6:00 PM**.

The Ceremony for The Disposal of Unserviceable Flags has been an integral part of American Legion ritual since 1937. Each year thousands of flags are collected at the Post. These Flags and those displayed on the Graves of our Veterans when faded, torn or otherwise unserviceable must be replaced. This Ceremony is your opportunity to dispose of your unserviceable Flags in the proper manner. Flags can be placed in the receptacle at the Legion at any time.

Participants in the Flag Disposal Ceremony must report to the Legion Field at **5:00 PM Sunday May 20st**.
