HACKETTSTOWN CLEAN COMMUNITIES PROGRAM GROUP CLEAN UP GUIDELINES

- 1. The group agrees to provide a minimum of ten (10) workers. Max of 25.
- 2. The group agrees to provide one (1) adult supervisor for every ten (10) workers under the age of 17.
- 3. Each group participant is expected to work a minimum of two (2) hours.
- 4. Clean up must be done within the boundaries of Hackettstown.
- 5. All recyclable material collected becomes the property of Hackettstown.
- 6. All recyclable material (bottles, cans, newspapers, cardboard, and tires) must be separated from debris.
- 7. Payment by Clean Communities program to the group will be \$10.00 per person. There is a minimum of \$150.00 and a maximum of \$500.00 to any one group per clean-up.
- 8. The Clean Communities Program will provide bags, gloves, was, mas, and/or shovels as needed. Borrowed from DPW, and returned prior to payment.
- 9. Pick up of litter and recyclables collected will be at designated locations coordinated by the Clean Communities Program.
