

## WARREN COUNTY SENIORS HOW TO MAKE AN APPOINTMENT FOR A COVID-19 VACCINE



- 1. Go to the Warren County website at www.co.warren.nj.us
- 2. Click on COVID-19 Vaccine
- 3. To make an appointment at one of the county vaccination sites, scroll down and click on the link here: "To book your appointment at one of the vaccine clinics conducted by Warren County, click here"
- 4. If you are 65+ years old and live, work, or go to school in Warren County, you are eligible to get the vaccine at one of the Warren County vaccine sites.
- 5. Click on the down arrow at "Select appointment type" and select "COVID-19 Moderna Vaccine."
- 6. Click on down arrow at "Select Site" and choose a location or no preference.
- 7. Next a calendar will pop up. Available dates are highlighted in blue.

If there are no available dates, we are likely at full capacity.

It does *not* mean we are booked for the next few months, it just means we are waiting on more vaccine. Dates are only opened 1-2 weeks at a time for now which is why all other weeks are grayed out. Please be patient with us during this busy time.

8. After you click on a date and time, fill in the information requested. Be sure to hit "finalize."

Make sure you type a valid email & get a confirmation email after you schedule. If you did not, it is likely that your appointment was not scheduled.
